THIS PRODUCT MUST BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE INSTALLATION CODE BY A PERSON FAMILIAR WITH THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE PRODUCT AND THE HAZARDS INVOLVED.

WARNINGS:

- Risk of electrical shock. Disconnect power at fuse or circuit breaker before installing or servicing.
- To prevent early lamp failure, lamp should only be installed in operating environments ranging between -30°C and +40°C (-22°F and +104°F).
- No user serviceable parts inside. To avoid electrical shock do not disassemble product.
- Risk of fire or electric shock, LED Retrofit Kit installation requires knowledge of luminaires electrical systems. If not qualified, do not attempt installation. Contact a qualified electrician.
- Risk of fire or electric shock, Install this kit only in luminaires that have the construction features and min dimensions shown in the Figure 1 and where the input rating of the retrofit kit does not exceed the input rating of the luminaire.
- Do not make or alter any open holes in an enclosure of wiring or electrical components during kit installation
- To prevent wiring damage or abrasion, do not expose wiring to edges of sheet metal or other sharp objects.
- Installers should not disconnect existing wires from lampholder terminals to make new connections at lampholder terminals, Instead installers should cut existing lampholder leads away from the lampholder and make new electrical connections to lampholder lead wires by employing applicable connectors.
- This retrofit kit is accepted as a component of a luminaire where the suitability of the combination shall be determined by authorities having jurisdiction.
- This device is not intended for use with emergency exits.
- This retrofit kits suitable for wet locations luminaires specified as below: Type Non IC; Type IC; Covered ceiling; Uncovered ceiling. Installers should examine all parts that are not intended to be replaced by the retrofit kit for damage and replace any damaged parts prior to installation of the retrofit kit.

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



INSTALLATION WITH J-BOX


1. Make sure power is turned off and the J-Box fixed on the ceiling surface. (Fig.1)


2. Connect the luminaire to supply wires with wire nut. Wire nut live (black) wire with Disk Light black wire and wire nut neutral (white) wire with Disk Light white wire. Wire nut ground (green) with Disk Light ground (green) wire. (Fig.2)


3. Remove lens by turning counter clockwise to unlock. (Fig.3)

4. Select desired CCT, on time, and PIR status. (Fig.4)

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
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INSTALLATION WITH J-BOX (cont'd)


5. Safely place all wires into the junction box, mount luminaire to the junction box and screws through the keyhole slots. (Fig.5)


6. Replace lens and twist clockwise to lock. (Fig.6)

7. Caulk around the mounting surface edge with silicone sealant. (Fig.7)




PIR SENSOR FUNCTION

Self check function: turn on at the first time, if no movement is detected within 12 seconds, the light will turn off.

- ① "AUTO": Fixture on and PIR active, the switch w/ hold-on function, but w/o stand-by function
- a) Select @30S: PIR triggered, fixture hold-on 30S @100% brightness, then off
 - b) Select @5Min: PIR triggered, fixture hold-on 5Min @100%, then off
 - c) Select @10Min: PIR triggered, fixture hold-on 10Min with 100% brightness, then off
- ② "Bi-level": PIR active, the switch w/ hold-on & stand-by function
- a) Select @30S: PIR triggered, fixture hold-on 30S @100% brightness, stand-by 30S @50% brightness, then off;
 - b) Select @5Min: PIR triggered, fixture hold-on 5Min @100% brightness, stand-by 5Min @50% brightness, then off;
 - c) Select @10Min: PIR triggered, fixture hold-on 10Min @100% brightness, stand-by +∞ @50% brightness;
- ③ "OFF" of dip-switch: PIR and light sensor disabled; fixture works as a regular light.

Note: AUTO and Bi-level switch: When the illuminance of the natural light lower than 65-75 lux, the light sensor will be turned off, and will trigger PIR sensor; When the natural light illuminance exceeds 75-85 lux, the light sensor will trigger and the fixture can't light up.



Note: These instructions do not cover all details or variations in equipment nor do they provide for every possible situation during installation, operation or maintenance.
