



THIS PRODUCT MUST BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE INSTALLATION CODE BY A PERSON FAMILIAR WITH THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE PRODUCT AND THE HAZARDS INVOLVED.

WARNING: Make certain power is OFF before installing the fixture. No user serviceable parts inside.

GUARD INSTALLATION

Wire Guard mounts with (4) #8-32 Stainless Steel Screws. Screws are provided with guard. Guard and shield may be used together. See *Fig 1* for Guard.

Line up **guard** with pre-existing, pre-drilled holes in frame as shown in *Fig 1*, and tighten screws.



CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

CAUTION: Be sure fixture temperature is cool enough to touch. Do not clean or maintain while fixture is energized.

- 1. Clean glass lens with non-abrasive glass cleaning solution.
- 2. Do not open the fixture to clean the LEDs. Do not touch the LEDs.
