

CORD TO STEM CONVERSION

- 1. Remove and discard the Cord Clamp, Canopy Cap and Gland Nut as shown in Fig. 4.
- 2. Insert Cord through Stem section as shown in Fig. 5. Screw Stem section to Fixture. Add up to 3 more Stem sections as required. Each Stem Section is 12" long.
- 3. Add the Swivel.
- **4.** Thread **Cord** through **Bolt Nut** and thread **Bolt Nut** onto **Swivel**, tighten securely. Refer to page 1 for mounting instructions.






